And the hop performs just as well in the brewhouse as in the field.

"Not every variety translates so clearly from raw hop aroma to finished beer, but Krush bursts with peach, mango, citrus, and tropical notes at harvest and adds a pop of these same flavors to every Krush beer I've tasted," said Tiffany Pitra, Senior Sensory Manager at Yakima Chief Hops. "While it already has a loyal following, I hope the official release of Krush inspires even more beers built around this juicy hop!"
